The Physicians' Charitable Foundation awards grants to organizations that serve the surrounding seven counties, including Montgomery, Miami, Greene, Darke, Clark, Preble and Warren counties. Grants are awarded for a variety of public charitable purposes which broadly encompass health care needs and at risk populations. Grants are awarded only to 501(c)(3) tax-exempt nonprofit organizations.

▶ **What we generally fund:**

- ▶ New health care projects or initiatives or an expansion of an existing project or initiative
- ▶ Projects that build organizational capacity in order to work more efficiently and effectively
- ▶ Capital campaign projects, including construction, renovation, furnishings and equipment

▶ **We generally do not fund:**

- ▶ Organizational operations
- ▶ Individuals or salaries
- ▶ Scientific, medical or academic research projects
- ▶ Operational deficits or reduced or lost funding
- ▶ Sectarian activities of religious organizations
- ▶ Scholarships
- ▶ Annual fundraising drives, ceremonies, special or one-time events
- ▶ Public or private schools
- ▶ Endowment funds

# Grant Applicants and Grant Deadlines:

- ▶ Applicants must be invited to apply each year prior to submitting their application. **Unsolicited applications will be returned.**
- ▶ Annual Grant Deadlines are March 2nd and September 1st.  
**NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Grant making policy and specific grant decisions are made by the Advisory Board following review by the Distribution Committee. The size and number of grant awards are directly related to the amount of money available each year. Generally, grants are made to help launch new projects and to established organizations for special purposes, which represent a unique and unduplicated opportunity and meet a significant community health need.

# Examples of Grants Awarded

## St. Vincent de Paul Shelter

St. Vincent shelter averages 420 clients per day which requires preparation of 1,260 meals days. They has 2 outdated and impaired stoves, with burners that did not work and an oven that was unable to maintain the correct temperature. PCF awarded them a grant to purchase 2 restaurant size stoves.



# Health Partners Free Clinic in Miami County

The clinic provides free health care and prescriptions to the uninsured and those who are insured but unable to afford the deductible and co-pay costs beyond their monthly premiums. The clinic served approximately 900 patients in 2017

# The Foodbank

**The Foodbank is an organization that PCF gives to annually. The Foodbank is the central coordinator of food distributed to approximately 106 food pantries in the Dayton area.**

# GEM City Market

GEM city market will be a cooperative grocery store located on lower Salem Ave. near downtown Dayton. The market is in response to the food desert seen in that area. The store will be a full service grocery with affordable, quality kitchen staples, fresh produce, and meat. It will be owned by its workers and consumers and also supporters from the community who can buy shares.
